Minutes of the Video Conference with all the Dy. Directors of Elementary Education held on 28th October, 2020 at 11.00 AM in the Directorate under the Chairmanship of Shri Shubh Karan Singh, Director Elementary Education, Himachal Pradesh.

At the outset, all the Dy.Directors in the Video Conference were welcomed. Following agenda items were discussed and decisions taken are as under:-

Har Ghar Pathshala

The Director urged the Dy. Directors to ensure that maximum students get connected to online learning and improve their learning experience. Specifically they were asked to -

- Find out block-wise and class-wise number of students connected through WhatsApp in the district and share the same with the Directorate.
- Talk to Principals personally and find out any concerns which they are facing.

WhatsApp-based assessment

The Chairman reviewed district-wise participation in WhatsApp groups and asked the Dy. Directors to share the steps taken by them to improve performance. District wise detail of students i.e. total enrolment, students connected through WhatsApp and number of students participated in Whatsapp quiz on 24th October, is as under:-

The Chairman took serious view on the gaps between the number of students connected through WhatsApp and number of students participated in WhatsApp quiz. In this regard, all the concerned Dy. Directors were requested to:

- Share analysis of gaps observed in student enrolment through WhatsApp and participation of students through WhatsApp.
- Coordinate with DDHE, DPO to devise a strategy and plan to ensure 100% participation of students in the weekly quiz. Share the plan and the implementation of the same with the Directorate.
- > Talk to private school Principals and find out how they will ensure full participation of students in online classes and online assessments.
- Motivate teachers for the following:
 - Teachers should go to different localities to motivate students to participate in online learning and quiz, and clarify their doubts.
 - O Teachers should telephonically contact all the students at least once in a week to resolve any issues faced by them. Such students who are not active on WhatsApp groups should specifically be contacted.

Teacher Training & SA1 data collection

- The Chairman reviewed district-wise submission of SA-1 assessment data and urged the Dy. Directors to ensure that all schools submit the result in a timely manner.
- The Chairman reviewed the district-wise completion of courses on The Teacher App and urged the Dy. Directors to ensure its full compliance.

Land Transfer Cases

It was apprised that data of school buildings constructed on Forest Land (FCA/FRA). Revenue land and Private land is still awaited from the Districts as desired in the previous meeting held on 25th September, 2020.

In the matter of schools building constructed on forest land, the Chairman desired following information:-

- Number of cases initiated under Forest Conservation Act(FCA)
- Number of cases initiated under Forest Rights Act (FRA).
- Number of cases which have not been initiated.

In this regard, all the Dy.DEEs were directed to send aforesaid information to the Directorate immediately as this data is urgently required by Public Accounts Committee(PAC).

It was further apprised that in matter of school buildings constructed on revenue land/other department (less than One Hectare), concerned Deputy Commissioner is competent for land transfer. In such cases, concerned Dy.DEEs were directed to contact with the concerned revenue authorities for the transfer of land in the name of Education Department.

Repairs/Construction of School buildings

All the Dy.DEEs were directed that cases of school buildings in which urgent repairs are required be sent to this Directorate at the earliest, so that funds could be sanctioned to these buildings on priority basis.

It was apprised that funds sanctioned for repair or civil works are lying unutilized in the district for long time. In this regard, all the concerned Dy.DEEs were directed to send the proposals to the Directorate at the earliest.

Disciplinary proceedings

As discussed in the previous meeting, all the Dy.DEEs were directed to expedite the pending disciplinary proceedings on priority basis. All the Dy.DEEs were further directed to review the enquiry cases lying pending at their own level or their subordinate level after every fortnight. It was apprised that some enquiries have been lying pending for the last 8 years. In this regard, all the concerned Dy.DEEs were

PAC/ Audit paras

The Chairman insisted upon the settlement of PAC/ Audit paras lying pending at field 1 level. All the Dy.DEEs were directed to follow up this issue regularly and take further steps for the settlement of PAC/ Audit Paras.

PMIS Status

All the Dy.DEEs were directed to take further necessary action regarding updation of PMIS Status of District Cadre employees on regular basis.


JBTs
